

Outstanding Service Among Undergraduate Students

This is to recognize a UF undergraduate student who engaged in service activities or projects that was exemplary. The activities can be co-curricular (outside of the classroom) or curricular (inside the classroom).

Requirements for the Outstanding Service Among Undergraduate Students

- Must be an undergraduate student.
- Students must submit a short 200-500 word essay answering the following question: Describe your involvement in service activities during your time as a UF student. What impact have you made with a community partner(s) and what have you learned from this experience?

Criteria	Average (Incomplete; parts were missing)	Fair (Straight to the point; complete; no examples were given)	Good (Overall good quality but nothing stood out in the nomination).	Outstanding (Specific examples are given; there is a good story that can be shared)
Narrative that makes you think, "This student contributed to the Gator Good."				
Grew and learned from the experience				
Student communicates the impact they had with a community partner
