

Outstanding Service Learning Or Community Based Learning Award Recipient

This is to recognize a UF undergraduate, graduate, or professional student who was enrolled in a service learning or did community based research as part of a course and extended their involvement in that project beyond the time of the class.

Requirements for the Outstanding Service Learning or Community Based Learning Award Recipient

- Must have a letter of recommendation from the faculty member who worked with the student in the class or research project
- Students must submit a short 200-500 word essay answering the following question: Describe your involvement in the service learning or community based learning experience. Why did you continue to work with this experience beyond the semester of the course and what have you learned from this experience?
